3. The student is subject to all rules and regulations of the university that bind all full-time students, including class attendance, class schedules, payment of fees, etc.
4. The student must be interviewed at the university in the company of at least one parent or guardian before enrolling.
5. The student is responsible for any impact on high school graduation caused by early withdrawal from the university.
6. The university will forward reports of final grades to high school officials.
7. **While enrolled in the Early Enrollment Program, the student is not eligible for federal financial aid, including Federal Work-Study, Federal Pell Grants and federal loans. The student WILL be eligible for JWU scholarships totaling up to 50 percent of any institutional aid he/she receives.**
8. The student must **submit a final official high school transcript** prior to entering his/her sophomore year at Johnson & Wales.
9. The student will be unable to participate in class scheduling online until all high school graduation requirements are met.
10. If a student changes his/her major during the Early Enrollment Program/freshman year at the university, a new Early Enrollment Program agreement form may need to be submitted to the university. In addition, it is the student's responsibility to schedule a meeting with an academic advisor to review how the decision to change his/her major could impact his/her graduation date.
11. For students entering the College of Culinary Arts or Restaurant, Food & Beverage Management where a student would need to participate in a culinary internship, the student must be 18 years old to participate in the internship, unless the student obtains an acknowledgment from the proposed internship site acknowledging that the student is not yet 18 years of age and stating that the student will not engage in any "particularly hazardous occupation" in accordance with the applicable Federal and state law.
